CHAMPIONSHIP REGISTRATION

For those competitors who have not yet registered for **2024/25 PROTYRE Circuit Rally Championship**, then we ask that you do so A.S.A.P. via the on-line championship registration system at **www.rallies.info/webentry/2025/circuitchamp/webentry.php** Registration is just £40 for Drivers and £25 for Co-drivers. Please note that Championship registration must be done in advance of starting your first event so that you are eligible to score points on that event. CHAMPIONSHIP DECALS

Competitors must display the Championship decals on their competition car throughout every championship event to qualify for Championship points. The decals are **17cm x 45cm** and must be affixed in a prominent location, one on each side of the car, above the centre line of the wheels. In addition, there will be 2 x 10cm oval Witham Motorsport Oils decals for each side of the car. Decals will be available at each CRC round from the CLO Josh Routledge, Tel 07749249759. For those registered competitors who have paid for them to be posted out in advance, they will be sent 1st class this weekend.

PROTYRE AWARDS

There is a valuable PROTYRE Award Scheme for all PROTYRE Circuit Rally Championship registered drivers who comply with the following: -

- Must complete the rally using only one brand of tyre and must carry decals for that brand of tyre (Michelin, Pirelli or Hoosier). Decals will be supplied at the event to facilitate this.
- Tyres supplied new must be purchased through PROTYRE or its affiliated suppliers JD Tyres or Tyres South Shore. (The Protyre Awards do not apply to tyres purchased part worn)
- Competitors taking part or wishing to do so must register for the Awards with the Circuit Rally Championship CLO Josh Routledge - at <u>Champ.coordinator@circuitrally.co.uk</u> with the Drivers name, Car, Class, Tyre make, and approx. date purchased from PROTYRE (or affiliates)

PROTYRE AWARDS on each Championship Event

Overall Awards: $1^{st} = 3$ tyres, $2^{nd} = 2$ tyres, $3^{rd} = 1$ tyre.

Awards in the designated Class: 1st = 3 tyres, 2nd = 2 tyres, 3rd = 1 tyre.

CHAMPIONSHIP SCRUTINEER: The Championship Scrutineer at the Neil Howard Stages will be Paul Hewer.

NOTE: Motorsport UK Regulations now require there to be a maximum limit on the number of tyres a competitor can use on each event. R48.5.11. [12 tyres on a Single Venue event up to 45 miles]. This will be specified in the Regulations on each event.

EVENT NOTES

The opening round of the 2024/25 CRC, the **Salford Van Hire Neil Howard Stages** on Saturday 2nd November has attracted a full entry including many CRC crews.

You are reminded that there will be a 'podium celebration' for the 3 leading crews shortly after they have finished the last stage. The event results will be finalised as quickly as possible, and the event awards presentation will take place soon after the results are final. This format of podium celebration > event results > event awards will be followed at all the CRC events.
